- Study the local news for a couple of weeks before you arrive so you know a little bit about what's going on. A good site could be: [www.thelocal.se](http://www.thelocal.se)
- Talk to your new colleagues well in advance. Maybe you have been working together for a long time, but they will probably have a lot of good local information to share.
- Talk to former expats about the feelings and experiences around their relocation process. Online, you will find a variety of expat communities and to connect with.
- Use social media such as Facebook, LinkedIn etc to connect and network with others. Maybe you will find groups of people that share your interests.
- If you have children that will attend School or Pre-School, network with other parents at the school. This is a great opportunity to meet others, both locals and other expats.
- Investigate different International Clubs or networks that arrange activity's locally.
- Walk around your neighborhood. There is no better way of discovering new things than by foot. If you are using a relocation company, make sure you ask them for tips on local activities and places.
- Take a new route to work every day. Invest in a trusty GPS that will guide you to your destination no matter what direction you start off from. This method will give you a good overview of your surroundings.
- Ask a lot of questions, be curious.
- Keep an open mind, listen to other people but remember to build your own opinion.
