

CIVIL REGISTRATION

When you move to Sweden, you might need to register with the Swedish Tax Agency. The type of registration depends on personal circumstances and how long you are planning to stay.

For a stay shorter than six (6) months, you are not required to register with the Swedish Tax Agency. As you are not subject to Swedish income taxation, you will not be eligible for Swedish social insurance.

For a stay between six (6) and 12 months, you are required to register with the Swedish Tax Agency to receive a tax coordination number. Your unique tax coordination number entitles you to limited social insurance benefits, such as medical and dental care.

For an assignment of 12 months or longer, you (and accompanying family, if any) are required to apply for Swedish personal identity numbers.

YOUR CIVIL REGISTRATION SERVICE

- Needs analysis
- Accompanied visit to the Swedish Tax Agency.
- Assistance with explaining, filling out and filing required documents at the Swedish Tax Agency.

KEEP IN MIND

You need to bring the below documentation to the Swedish Tax Agency to complete your registration:

- Biometric Passport
- Residence Permit Card (UT) for non-EU members
- Original Employment Contract/Proof of Employment
- Complete information on your accommodation

If applicable (Original):

- Birth Certificates (for children, if any)
- Marriage Certificate
- Divorce Papers

Other documents may be required based on your circumstances.
