*The Swedish Tax Agency Identify Card (ID card) is an approved form of identification in Sweden. The ID card can be used to verify your identity at places such as hospitals, medical clinics, banks, and shops. The ID card also contains electronic identification (e-legitimation). This may be used to securely verify your identity over the internet.*

## PROCESS

To apply for an ID card, you need to visit the Swedish Tax Agency. Please make sure to submit the application fee well in advance, at least two working days before the visit. In order for the application to be accepted, you must present proof of payment (receipt). The ID card application fee is SEK 400.

### **For payments in Sweden, pay the fee into either of the following accounts:**

### **For international payments:**

- IBAN (International Bank Account Number) SE30 9500 0099 6034 0504 0621
- Swift/BIC NDEASESS

When making the payment, please remember to quote your Swedish personal identity number in the field for messages/other information. Print the payment confirmation, as you must present it at the Tax Agency.

### **Bring the following documents to the Tax Agency:**

- Receipt of payment
- Passport – please note that only passports with biometric details and/or a chip are accepted. International ID cards are not accepted.
- UT card – if you are a non-EU citizen
